BY-LAW NUMBER 2024-31

BEING A BY-LAW TO IMPLEMENT AN ENERGY CONSERVATION & DEMAND MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS The Ontario Regulation 507/18 states the all municipalities have an Energy Conservation & Demand Management Plan; and

WHEREAS Ontario Regulation requires municipalities to report annually on their energy usage and greenhouse gas emissions, and

WHEREAS Every municipality is to update their energy conservation and demand management (CDM) plan every 5 years, and

WHEREAS Council deems it necessary to implement an Emergency Conservation & Demand Management Plan for the Corporation of the Township of Matachewan.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT we the Council of the Township of Matachewan **HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

- 1. **THAT** the municipality shall complete an Emergency Conservation & Demand Management Plan no later than five years after the day its previous Emergency Conservation & Demand Management Plan was completed.
- 2. **THAT** the municipality complete a review of its Emergency Conservation & Demand Management Plan no later than 12 months after,
 - (a) the day its Emergency Conservation & Demand Management Plan was completed; and
 - (b) the day its previous review was completed.
- 3. **THAT** the municipality shall also review its Emergency Conservation & Demand Management Plan whenever necessary.
- 3. **THAT** the municipality shall revise its Emergency Conservation & Demand Management Plan if it is necessary to reflect,
 - (a) any significant changes in the mandatory profiles;
 - (b) any other significant matters arising from the review.
- 4. THAT the municipality does not have to review its Emergency Conservation & Demand Management Plan if it expects to complete a new Emergency Conservation & Demand Management Plan on or before the day it would complete the review.
